



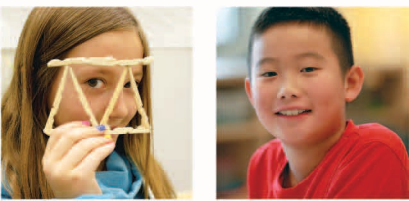

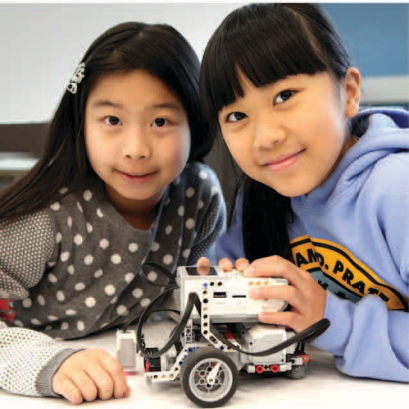


- Most important way to make a difference

- Please begin the process for volunteer clearance early – without this, you cannot volunteer



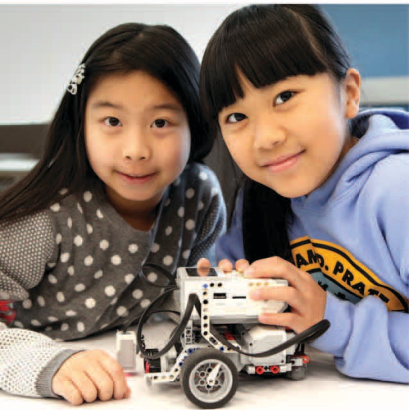
Questions

Staff and Student Data



- Just over 450 students at this time
 - Approx. 80% are bused
 - 54% English as an Additional Language
 - 12% identified with unique learning needs
- Kindergarten – 1.5 classes
- Grade 1 – 3 classes
- Grade 2-4 – 4 classes
- PEW and Art taught by classroom teachers
- Music and French Specialists
- One teacher who provide intervention (.4)

Staff and Student Data Cont...



- Complexity Team
 - 1 Teacher
 - 2 Educational Assistants
- Support Staff includes: Lead Lunch Supervisor, 2 Lunch Supervisors, 3 EAs, 2 EALs, 2 School Assistants, Library Assistant

Questions

Preparing for School



- Start routine early (first week of August)
 - Going to bed on time
 - Not taking naps during the day
 - Following instructions
- Review bus and walking safety rules
- Visit the school, playground, and entry doors
- Practice phone number and address
- Validate nervous feelings

Continued...



- Learn coping skills and finding solutions to problems
- Expose student to challenges
- Don't jump in to fix things
 - Consequences do some of the teaching
- Engage in unpreferred tasks

Preparing for School – Kindergarten and Grade 1



Practice

- Tying shoes (or purchase shoes with Velcro closure)
- Putting on coat and doing up the zipper
- Opening and closing the zipper on the backpack and lunch bag
- Opening containers for lunch and snack
- Reading and saying first and last name

Dropping Off and Picking Up



Terry Road

- Safe drop off and pick up zone along the passenger side of Terry Road
 - 2 openings in the fence



Thornhill Drive

- Safe drop off and pick up zone on the passenger side
 - 2 openings in the fence



Safe Zones



- Terry Road and Thornhill Drive have breaks in the fence, parents can park along these road and walk their children across the field
- A large portion of Trafford Drive is designated as no parking, this would be to allow your child to exit the vehicle for them to walk to the school alone
- The **yellow** areas are the park and walk zones
- The **red** area is a drop-off zone (you cannot park and walk your child to the school)
- The **blue** area shows busing, do not stop in this area

Bus Registration



- Deadline – **June 14 (firm)**
- CBE uses this information to plan all routes
- If you miss the deadline, you may be driving your students for the first 6-8 weeks of school
- Please register your student prior to the deadline
